After researching the qualifications and checking her credit score, Kristie decided to apply for the homeownership program at the local Rutherford County Area Habitat for Humanity. She is learning a great deal and it is also helping push her out of her comfort zone to be more outgoing. When the home is complete, and they are settled, Kristie plans on reading, enjoying a cup of tea, and watching the night sky with her kids.

"The building of this house is also helping to build a firm foundation for us," she said. "Just like my grandparents provided for us, I have always wanted a place my family could come home to."
